David Fahrenthold joined the Washington Post in 2000 as a summer intern, and never left. He began his Post career on the Metro desk, covering the night-cops shift, then the D.C. Police department, then the Chesapeake Bay and the local environment. After that, he moved to the National staff, covering New England, the environment, Congress, government waste, and then the 2016 election. In 2016, Fahrenthold was awarded the Pulitzer Prize in national reporting for his coverage of Donald Trump's charitable giving (or lack thereof). He lives in Northwest DC with his wife and two daughters.
